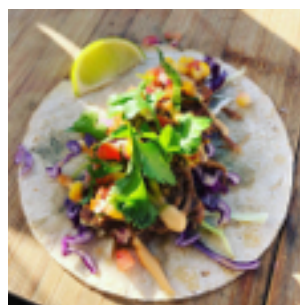
Sunday Night (Official Regatta Dinner)

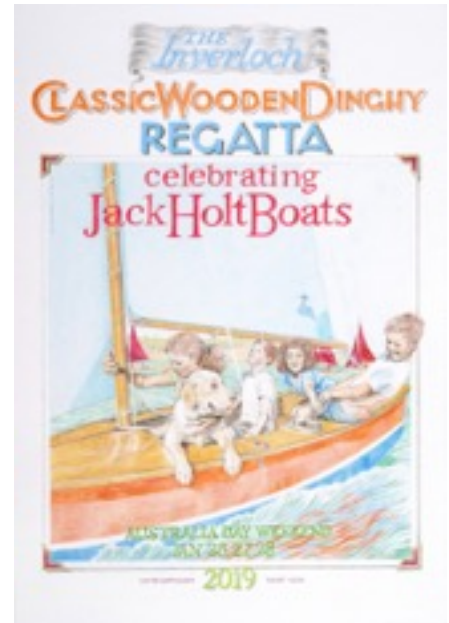
