



Notice of Regatta

Saturday 17th & Sunday 18th February 2024

1. INTRODUCTION

The South Gippsland Yacht Club will once again host the Regatta, now in its 10th year, over the weekend of the 17th and 18th of February for classic dinghies of all classes.

The Inverloch Classic Wooden Dinghy Regatta is for the display and racing of historic and classic dinghies of a type typically sailed prior to 1985 that used to be once a familiar sight at beaches around Australia. These will be principally of wooden construction and traditional rigging with timber or aluminum spars, however boats with a hull incorporating composite materials plus timber deck (eg. NS14) may also be considered at the discretion of the organizing committee. A brief history of the boat (and optional photo) should be provided as part of the entry documentation and organizers will arrange a display of information for public appreciation.

The Regatta includes social activities, a series of 4 races and a relaxed display of classic boats, however in response to entrant feedback; there will be less emphasis on static boat judging. Sailors entering their classic or historic wooden dinghy in one or more of the scheduled races will be eligible for a range of awards and prizes. Awards for boat presentation will be based on voting by a mix of entrants, SGYC members and event sponsors or ambassadors. A scoring system will be developed and advised prior to the event. All participants will receive a commemorative plaque and a regatta shirt per paid boat entry.

Young sailors participating in at least 2 races during the Regatta will receive a cash award courtesy of Bendigo Bank, Inverloch and are eligible for the overall "Best Youth Sailor" Award.

An informal Regatta dinner comprising pre-dinner nibbles, main and desert will be held on the Saturday evening and participants are encouraged to return their entry form and book early to ensure availability.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Regatta is open to members of yacht clubs affiliated with Australian Sailing who will sail a dinghy that complies with these rules.

3. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for sailors entering boats is as follows:

- Adults \$80
- Juniors \$50
- Entry fee is per boat and includes one commemorative Regatta shirt and boat plaque.
- Additional shirts \$30.

Please advise your shirt size on the entry form so we may endeavour to supply the right size, however as shirts are pre-ordered, we cannot guarantee.

4. DINNER BOOKING & LUNCHESES

The Regatta Dinner at the Yacht Club will be held on the Saturday night and will require booking. The cost for this 3-course dinner will be \$37 per head for adults and \$20 per head for juniors, excluding drinks, available from the bar. **Please note: previous years dinners were a sellout, so booking this along with your entry is strongly advised and will greatly assist in the running of the event.**

Light lunches will be available on both the Saturday and Sunday and these can be booked and paid for at registration. SGYC will do it's best to accommodate dietary requirements.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from 10.00 am on Saturday 17th February 2023 at the SGYC Clubhouse and on the SGYC website: www.sgycinverloch.com.au

7. REGATTA SITE

All sailing will be held on the waters of Anderson Inlet, Inverloch. Boats will be displayed on the beach in front of the clubhouse and/or within the club compound, if required by tide or weather.

8. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will comprise a number of loops and marks will be set depending on available water, current, wind direction and weather. The Race Officer will make the final decision on the day.

9. DIVISIONS

The number of starts will be determined by the Race Officer.

10. HANDICAPS

Yardsticks developed using Australian Sailing, South Gippsland Yacht Club and historical data and appropriate for a range of classic dinghies will be used. Yardsticks may be adjusted within each boat class based on the age and build materials of an individual boat.



11. RACE SCORING

There will be race awards for place getters across each of the 4 races with the best 3 results counting towards the "Regatta Ginn Cup" series final score. The Low point scoring system will apply.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

13. PRIZES

Prizes and/or trophies will be presented to the place getters in the following races and categories:

Sailing:

- **Race 1 through 4:** First place.
- **Ginn Cup Series (best of 3 races):** First, Second & Third placings.
- **Jack Carroll Memorial Trophy for Sailfish:** Best of 3 races in series, First place.
- **Youth Sailor Trophy:** Best result in series for a junior sailor in the regatta.
- **Adhoc Awards:** A bit of fun as judged by the Regatta committee!

Regatta Dinner:

- **Door Prize Saturday Regatta Dinner:** Raffle

Classic Wooden Dinghy Category Awards, onshore:

- **Best Presented Australian Sailfish - Perpetual Trophy**
- **Overall 'Best In Show' Boat - Inverloch & District Lions Club Perpetual Trophy**

The presentation of Awards will be awarded at the SGYC Club house on Sunday 19th afternoon after the last race.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Attention is drawn to page 4 of the Registration Form, Waiver. SGYC has Public Liability Insurance cover for the event; however any additional insurance for competing boats is the sole responsibility of the entrant. Each participating boat should be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000

Sailing is deemed a community sport and as such all are welcome to participate in the sailing and display activities of the Regatta. Social distancing is to be observed when practical. For your own safety, we encourage all participants to be fully vaccinated.
